Music for All's mission is to create, provide, and expand positively life-changing experiences through music for all.

OUR VISION

Music for All will be a catalyst to ensure that every child across America has access and opportunity to participate in active musicmaking in his or her scholastic environment.

Music for All has been a destination – and set the standard – for scholastic music ensemble performance and music education advocacy since its founding in 1975.

Music for All's programmatic model is designed to mirror, supplement, and extend the classroom and performance model adopted in most American scholastic settings. Music for All provides ensemble experiences, hands-on opportunities for individual student performance training, and student and teacher growth and development.

Music for All is also committed to informing and empowering students, parents, and teachers to be engaged advocates for the arts and music education in their communities and across the nation.

A 501(c)(3) nonprofit educational organization, Music for All's programs include more than 45 annual events, serving more than 500,000 attendees each year – more than 1.3 million since our founding. Our educational events include the Bands of America Grand National Championships and Regional Championships for marching bands, the Music for All Summer Symposium camp for students and teachers, the Music for All National Festival, student leadership programs, national honor ensembles for concert band, jazz band, orchestra, and the Bands of America Honor Band that will march for the fifth time in the Rose Parade® in 2022.

Impacted by the pandemic, Music for All began creating and providing new services for educators in 2020, including producing several series of Webinars, collaborating with MusicProfessor to provide online music instruction, and developing virtual performance and remote feedback opportunities.

 The Bands of America Honor Band will march in the Rose Parade* in Pasadena, California for the fifth time, on New Year's Day 2022.

- Founded in 1975, Music for All celebrates its 45th anniversary in 2020.

- BOA Honor Band performs before millions, in the Rose Parade as part of the President's Award-winning unit created with NAMM and Sesame Street.
- The BOA Alumni Campaign reaches its fundraising goal of \$250,000, raised in 81 days, prior to Feb. 28, 2009.
- Music for All debuts the Middle School National Music Festival.
- Gayl Doster named
 Volunteer of the Year by the International Festival and Events Association.

- Orchestra America, a division of BOA, debuts the Honor Orchestra of America at the National Concert Band Festival.

- Music for All Foundation, in partnership with other organizations, works in Arkansas to secure the first legislative mandate for music and arts education for any state.
- Music for All Foundation launches "Music for All" awareness campaign and cause-related product line.

- Music for All Foundation releases Sound of Silence: The Unprecedented Decline of Music Education in California Public Schools, documenting the 50% decline in music participation in California Schools.

- BOA opens new headquarters in historic Union Station, downtown

- Indianapolis.
- BOA creates the Bands of America Hall of Fame and inducts the inaugural class.
 BOA receives an invitation for the Bands of America Honor Band to perform in the 2005 Rose Parade.
- Music for All Foundation is founded with a mission to expand access to music and arts education programs through pioneering research, public policy and advocacy efforts.

- BOA debuts the Orchestra Division at the Summer Symposium.
- The Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra presents a special Bands of America tribute concert at the National Concert Band Festival and National Percussion Festival.

 The Honor Band of America, conducted by H. Robert Reynolds, presents a concert tour of Japan, performing exchange concerts with top Japanese bands.

- The Internal Revenue Service recognizes Bands of America, Inc., as a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization, retroactive to 1984 when BOA filed for status.

 The Student Leadership Workshop is added to the Summer Workshop.

- 1984 marks a major turning point in Bands of America's history. Formerly part of a parent company, BOA separates to become a new, self-supporting organization renamed Bands of America, Inc.




